General Structure:

The Master's Degree EUR-Organic is entirely taught in English and offers an all-embracing system-led (further-) education in the fields "Organic Agriculture and Food Systems" through its compulsory and elective courses.

Every student has to study at two partner universities and is awarded – upon successful completion – a Master's Degree by both of the chosen universities:

1. + 2. Semester at the HOME University	BOKU, AU or UHOH – where the student starts the degree and studies the basics of Organic Agriculture and Food Systems.
3. + 4. Semester at the HOST University	BOKU, AU, UHOH or WULS – where the student is deepening knowledge in one of the offered specialisations.

The international focus provides opportunities to deepen academic as well as scientific qualifications and opens up occupational outlooks in businesses, which operate on an international level and in the field of organic agriculture as well as the related food industry.

BOKU taken as HOME-University (1st and 2nd Semester) you accomplish 60 ECTS-Credits:

1. 6 ECTS-Credits: Compulsory Start-up Module - is taking place from 8th to 13th of September 2013!
