# How to find courses sorted by BOKU departments / institutes

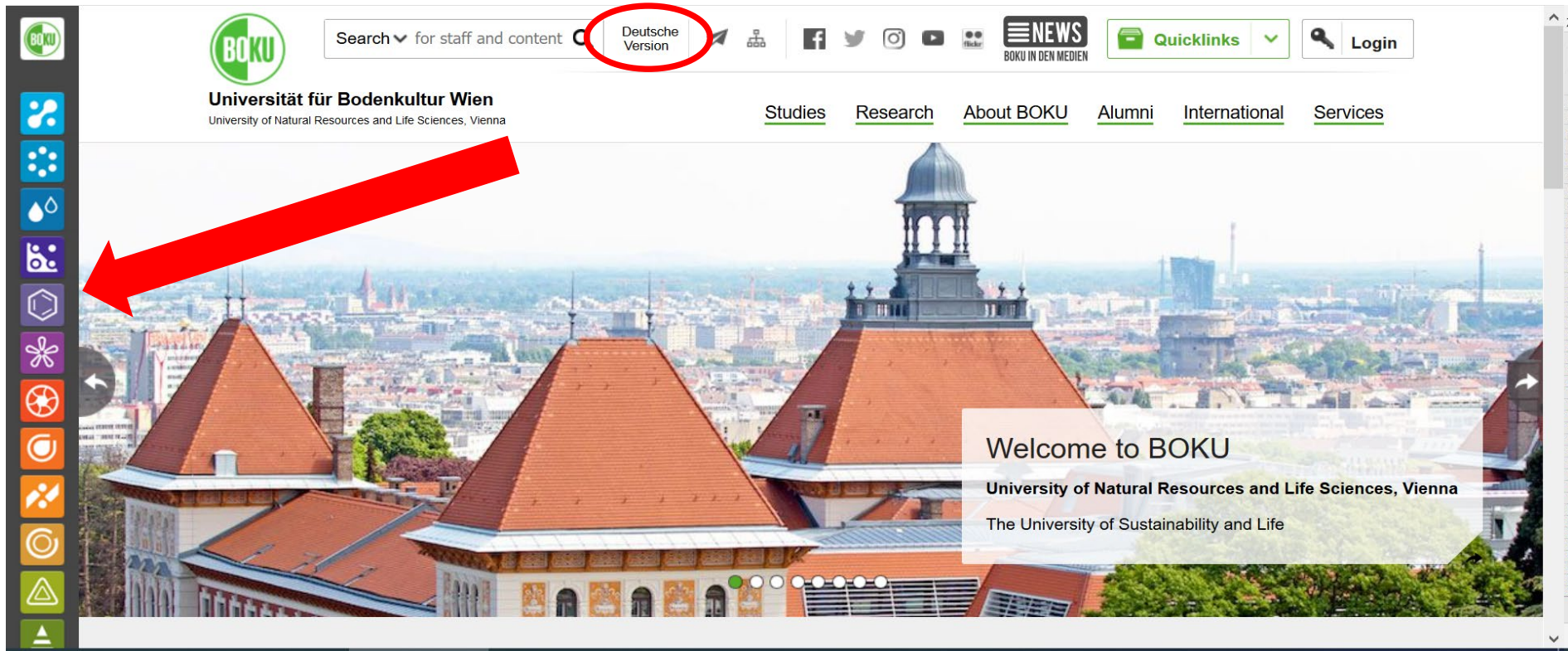
You can choose courses from all departments /


