

Library use - checklist for new BOKU-students

Library card

For BOKU-students the BOKUcard is the library card. It is necessary to register for library use, therefore please bring the BOKUcard and the filled in application form [[download](#)] to the library. Your student-ID number (“Matrikelnummer”) is your ID in the library’s online system.

Borrowing, reserving, extension of loan period

Borrowing books is free of charge. You need a valid library card/registered BOKUcard. You can extend the loan period of borrowed books and reserve borrowed books yourself in your library user account:

Using electronic library-resources

If you are on the BOKU-campus all electronic resources of the library (e-books, e-journals, databases) are accessible without login.

BOKU-Students can also access these resources on campus via Wi-Fi on their own notebooks/devices.
