

Hlawka Prize 2006 awarded to Manfred Kühleitner

The Austrian Academy of Sciences has decided to award the

"Edmund-and-Rosa-Hlawka-Prize 2006"

to **Manfred Kühleitner**, in recognition of his achievements in the fields of

Number Theoretic Analysis and of the Geometry of Numbers.

Dr. Manfred Kühleitner received his Ph.D. from the University of Vienna. Currently he is associate professor of mathematics at the Institute of Mathematics of BOKU Wien (University of Natural Resources and Applied Life Sciences, Vienna). His main research interests in Number Theory include lattice points in large bodies, divisor problems, and the asymptotic theory of arithmetic functions.
