1. Mongolian State University of Agriculture (MSUA), Mongolia

Full-time credit load (Undergraduate)

For the 4 years Bachelor program a student has to take 120 credits.

Full workload per year is 30 credits.

Full-time credit load (Master)

A Master program requires 33 credits (27 lessons and 6 for thesis)

Full-time credit load (PhD)

A PhD program requires 63 credits (51 lessons and 12 for thesis)

1 credit equals 32 academic hours; 1 academic hours = 45 min; 1 credit (=32 academic hours) equals to 16 hours of lectures and 16 hours of self study under supervision of lecturer. Self-study is seminars, presentations and reports which should be done by the student under the certain topic.

2. Hanoi University of Technology (HUT), Vietnam

Full-time credit load (Undergraduate)

For the 4 (4.5) years Bachelor program a student has to take 132-145 (148-265) credits.

Full workload per semester is 17-24 credits.

Full-time credit load (Master)

Full workload per semester is 17-24 credits.

A Master program takes 2 years (with a Bachelor degree) and 1 year (with an engineer degree). A higher Engineer Degree is a 5 year program with 160-180 credits in total (can be compared with BSc+1 year MSc).

3. University of Economics Hochiminh City (UEH), Vietnam

4. National University of Laos (NUOL), Laos

Full-time credit load (Undergraduate)

For the 5 years Bachelor program a student has to take 120-150 credits. Full workload per year is 24-34 credits.

Full-time credit load (Master)

Full workload per semester is 6-15 credits. A Master program takes 2 years.

5. Suranaree University of Technology (SUT), Thailand

Full-time credit load (Undergraduate)

For the 4 years Bachelor program a total of 240 credits are required. Full workload per year is 60 credits (20 credits per trimester).

Full-time credit load (Master)

For the 2 years Master program a total of 120 credits are required. Full workload per year is 60 credits (20 credits per trimester).

Full-time credit load (PhD)

For the 3 years PhD program a total of 180 credits are required. Full workload per year is 60 credits (20 credits per trimester).

6. Chiang Mai University (CMU), Thailand

Full-time credit load (Undergraduate)

For the 4 years Bachelor program a total of 135-145 credits are required. Full workload per semester is 18 credits.

1 credit hour equals 45 working hours. 3 working hours equal 1 teaching hour.

Full-time credit load (Master)

For the 2 years Master program a total of 25-35 credits are required. Full workload per semester is 9 credits.

1 credit equals 67.5 working hours. 4.5 working hours equal 1 teaching hour.

7. Thammasat University (TU), Thailand

Full-time credit load (Undergraduate)

Full-time workload is 36 credits per year (18 per semester).

Full-time credit load (Master)

Full-time workload is 18 credits per year (9 per semester).

1 hour of course equals 3 credits. 1 course is 3 hours of lecture per week (16 weeks per semester).

8. Tadulako University (UNTAD), Indonesia

Full-time credit load (Undergraduate)

For the 3.5-5 years Bachelor program a total of 154-160 credits are required (including 6 credits Bachelor work and 4 credits mandatory community service). Full workload per semester is 12-24 credits. Students can take a maximum of 48 credits per year.

Full-time credit load (Master)

For the 2 years Master program a total of 45-55 credits are required. Students write their Master thesis in 1 semester. Full workload per semester is 12-24 credits. Students can take a maximum of 48 credits per year.

Full-time credit load (PhD)

A PhD program lasts 3 years. 1 year student take classes (total of 15-24 credits). 2 years students work on their PhD work.

9. Padjadjaran University (FE UNPAD), Indonesia

Full-time credit load (Undergraduate)

A Bachelor program usually takes 3.5-4.5 years. Full workload per year is 48-60 credits (max 24 per semester plus max. 12 credits (optional, called “short semester”) during semester break (July-August).

Full-time credit load (Master)

A Master program usually takes 1.5-2 years. Full workload per year is 30-36 credits (max 15 per semester).

Full-time credit load (PhD)

A PhD program usually takes between 3.5 and 4 years (minimum 3 years). 56 credits (incl. PhD work) are required.

10. Northwest A&F University (NWAUFU), China

Full-time credit load (Undergraduate)

For the 4 year Bachelor program a total of 160 credits is required. There is no requirement per semester.

Full-time credit load (Master)

For the 2-3 year Master program a total of 30 credits is required. There is no requirement per semester. An international student has to take a Minimum of 28 credits.

Full-time credit load (PhD)

For the 3-4 year PhD program a total of 16 credits is required. There is no requirement per semester. An international student has to take a Minimum of 12 credits.

For a theoretical course 1 credit equally 20 hours. For a physical education course 1 credit equals 30 hours.

11. Nanjing Agricultural University (NAU), China

Full-time credit load (Undergraduate)

A Bachelor program takes 4 years and a total of 220 credits is required. A full workload per year is 55 credits.

Full-time credit load (Master)

A Master program takes 3 year and a total of 30 credits is required for course study, which did not include thesis writing and internship.

Full-time credit load (PhD)

A PhD program takes 3 years and can be extended to 6 years. It requires a total of 18 credits for course study.
