I prepared the lecture about aromatic and medicinal Vietnamese herbs and given it to master students at Institute of Tropic and Sub tropic. I participated to develop the protocol to measure the Xanthine Oxidase Inhibition (XOI) activity of medicinal plants by using micro plate. I also participated to measure XOI activity of Czech and Vietnamese medicinal plants by using UV spectrophotometer with colleagues at Faculty of Agrobiolgy, Food and Natural Resources. I had a seminar on Home University (HUT) and on my research products at Faculty of Agrobiolgy, Food and Natural Resources. I taken part in master thesis defend of students. With others Vietnamese staffs and student, I prepared the report about Vietnam country, Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh cities and about our university to presented in the meeting of Erasmus Mundus scholarships at CULS. I visited Kozen brewery with colleagues and students, visited Green House at CULS. In the weekend, we visited also the famous places in Prague and some other cities of Czech.

I had the occasion to exchange the experiences of lecture preparation and teaching with colleagues at CULS. I also had more experiences of research on Xanthine Oxidase Inhibition activity of medicinal plants.
