"The Raccoon: A Natural History and An Unnatural Future"

Prof. Sam Zeveloff, Weber State University, Utah Fulbright Professor at the BOKU

The common raccoon (*Procyon lotor*) is one of the most successful mammals in North America. Its distribution has substantially increased in the past few decades, and it thrives in human-dominated landscapes. Concomitantly, it has expanded its range as a non-native species in Europe, and is becoming numerous in Austria. In this presentation, Prof. Zeveloff reviews the raccoon's natural history, and the challenges it poses for wildlife management and society.
