1. Grants for students who study abroad in one of the programme countries

The programme countries are classified into three country groups according to the European Commission's Programme Guide, for which the following grant levels have been set in Austria:

Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Northern Macedonia, Poland, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Turkey	390

2. Top-ups for students with fewer opportunities

Students with fewer opportunities receive an additional monthly top-up of € 250.

This group includes:

- Students with children in need of care who are taken to the place of study.
- Students with disabilities.
- Students with a chronic illness, if this results in increased financial expenditure during the stay abroad (compared to the stay in the sending country).

3. Travel support for environmentally friendly travelling (Green Travel)

Students who choose to travel in an environmentally friendly way, receive a one-time top-up in the amount of \in 50.

According to the European Commission's Programme Guide, Green Travel includes loweremission ways of travelling, such as:

- Train
- Bus or
- Car pooling

The grant and top-up rates above (points 1, 2 and 3), are valid as of 01.08.2022.
